- Sterilise all injection apparatus by boiling before use. Avoid use of strong disinfectants on apparatus.
- Maintain cleanliness at all times.
- 3. Keep needles sharp and clean; replace frequently.
- Use shortest needle possible, certainly not exceeding 15 mm.
- As far as is possible avoid injection of animals in wet weather or under dusty conditions.
- 6. This product must be injected only under the skin.
- 7. If possible inject high on the neck behind the ear.
